

Mark lines at 18mm and 32mm from the drilled end. Cut the bird mouth as shown in the drawing. Turn a dowel to be a snug fit the hole, sand or plane a flat as shown (approximately to 14mm) Push the dowel into the hole until it shows in the bird mouth, test whistle and adjust fipple as necessary to get a good sound. Super glue in place, (WARNING ENSURE THE GLUE IS DRY BEFOR TESTING AGAIN) Sand or cut the mouth piece. Reverse chuck and turn the other end to the
